

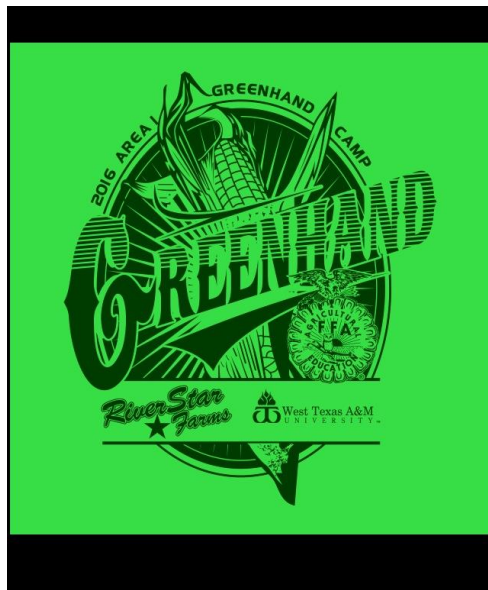

The Rodeo is September 14, 15

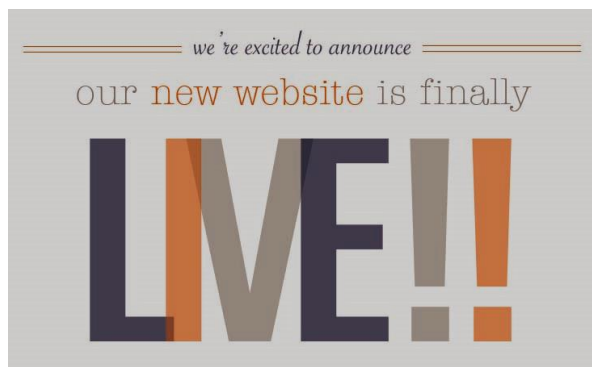
